## **SHIRE-CROSS REGISTRY**

### ***Shire-Cross Recordation Procedures***

***The Shire-Cross Certificate of Recordation is issued to a horse sired by a Registered Shire stallion out of a light breed mare. The stallion must be registered in the stud book of the Canadian Shire Horse Association (CSHA), the American Shire Horse Association (ASHA) or the Shire Horse Society, England (SHS). The Certificate of Recordation is a record of parentage only and does not constitute Registration in the CSHA Stud Book.***

#### **Procedure:**

- 1. The “Application for Certificate of Recordation” and “Shire-Cross Description Form” must be completed and signed by the owner of the horse to be recorded.**
- 2. Photographs of the horse, both sides and front, must accompany the application.**
- 3. Horses of any age are eligible. Do not complete the markings sheet for a foal until it has shed its foal hair.**
- 4. The fee for recordation must accompany the application. The fee is \$40.00 and the cheque should be made payable to the Canadian Shire horse Association.**

#### **Stallion owners please note:**

**The Certificate of breeding section on the Application for Certificate of Recordation must be completed and given to the mare owner at the time of service, when the mare is proven to be in foal or when a live foal is born, according to your service agreement. #### **Mare owners please note:**

**Please ensure that the Certificate of Breeding section has been completed by the stallion owner before submitting your application.**

**NOTE: Blood typing or DNA testing is not required.**
